



Maine Gutter Works – Gutter Installer Vetting Cheat Sheet

Print tips: set margins to 0.5 inches, choose black-and-white or grayscale if preferred, and bring a pen for notes. These seven questions help you compare any gutter installer near me on licensing, quality, and warranty.

#	Question & Notes
1	Are you licensed, bonded, and insured in Maine? (license #, liability limits, bond details)
2	Do you recommend seamless or sectional gutters for my home - why? (on-site roll-forming?)
3	What hanger spacing and fastening method will you use? (hidden hangers every 24 in?)
4	Which gutter materials and profiles can you fabricate? (aluminum gauge, K-style vs. half-round)
5	How strong is your warranty, and is it transferable? (labor years, material finish years)
6	Can I see recent local projects or speak with references? (addresses within 30 miles)
7	What is the timeline, cleanup plan, and payment schedule? (debris disposal, lien waiver)

Quick Red-Flag Checklist

- Suspiciously low bid (thin metal or off-brand sealant)
- Cash-only demand or today-only pricing pressure
- No physical address or unbranded vehicles
- Refusal to share license, insurance proof, or references
